# **Principal Reports -**

**Kevin Dorken, Lyon** - Thanks for coming out in this weather.

- Changes in conference schedule due to 2/28. Will communicate that to parents.
- GEF Grant team at Lyon put together grant for Lyon Learning Center. Oldest untouched space in district. Want to change space to fit learning flexible for large group, small group, individual learning. Grant submitted to work with consultants call Third Teacher (space is 3rd teacher). Kids have been involved already. Started reorganizing space already.

- Please get word out that kindergarten registration is in a month 2/20. Also for new 1st and 2nd graders.
- -Instructional Leadership Principal walk throughs. Past 3 years
  Focus on the learning targets that teachers share in the classroom.
  Shift in December principals looking for more depth when
  talking to students. In-depth list of questions want to hear how
  teachers are asking students to demonstrate their learning of the
  target. How well to show their knowledge/understanding of the target.
  Helps kids self-evaluate. Kids taking ownership of their learning

**Frank Rottman, Pleasant Ridge** - Thank you for coming out in this weather.

- Thank you for feedback on Jump Rope for Heart
- Baseline Data Collection System (Principal Walk Throughs) see kids becoming more aware of their learning. Makes data valuable. Helps teachers
- Dad's Club has been very successful. Dad's Breakfast on Friday was v. successful. Kids excited to "buy" breakfast for dads. One more this year. January 31 Dad's Club movie Despicable Me 2. 6:30.
